

Thank you for being part of the Cleveland National Forest Foundation (CNFF) fundraising art auction.

Local Julian artists have joined with the Julian Action Committee to support the Cleveland National Forest Foundation as it petitions San Diego County for conservation and sensible, lawful development in the Julian area.

Your participation in the auction today will help raise awareness and help raise funds for CNFF to continue advocating conservation and lawful development of the beautiful Julian landscape that routinely inspires both Julian community members and visitors alike.

In October 2016 the San Diego County Board of Supervisors granted development approval for the Hoskings Ranch 24-lot residential subdivision despite the February 2016 California Department of Conservation letter finding “the proposed subdivision inconsistent with the Williamson Act and the Subdivision map Act.”

The Cleveland National Forest Foundation filed suit in November 2016 challenging the decision of the County of San Diego and its Board of Supervisors to approve the residential estate Hoskings Ranch subdivision project.

Julian residents and concerned members of the CNFF, Sierra Club, Native Plant Society and other San Diego County residents have been writing letters, speaking publicly, and working with San Diego County to better understand the impact of the proposed Hoskings Ranch residential subdivision on the Julian community.

HELEN PETRE





work continues to enhance the broader community as he was lead designer at City Height's Manzanita Gathering Place, and three consecutive Take Back the Alley projects, which has grown into a regional movement.
